Principal's Report:

Thank you for the SAC funds that approved fourteen classroom projectors and six Elmo machines. These will help our students to learn and grow at JCE.

Dr. Joyner asked for a status report on all of our staff members. Dr. Joyner is committed to helping our community with support. Many of our district personnel supported our community during the hurricane at shelters. Our district is working on getting a waiver for the hurricane days. We will communicate the information as we receive it.

New Business:

Welcome Kathy Gilmore with St. Johns learning as a community business partner and Tee'haCarroll joining us as a parent member. The new members were voted in and approved as SAC members. Thank you for supporting our school!

IXL, a computer learning enhancement, has been approved K-5 and will begin in classrooms beginning Monday October 17th in Kindergarten through Fifth Grade.

Data Training for SAC Members: Mrs. Foster trained our SAC members how data is used to enhance student growth and learning. WOW Wednesdays are one of the resources used to dig deeper in the Florida State Standards to ensure we are meeting the needs of our students. Administrators and teachers are using the data to aid in the instruction of our students.

Mrs. Carroll discussed the outcome of the District Focus Group meeting on September 14th. Dr. Joyner shared the concern with our state education funding and provided suggestions for how we can move forward to be a successful county. An advocacy group is being formed to address the funding needs of our state and county.
