The following are some very important procedures and requests that we would like to share with you:

- The Continental Expeditions are open to all current K-5th graders (2023-2024 school year).
- Registration fee is \$50 per explorer, for the 1st expedition. \$25 per explorer, for each additional expedition thereafter.
- Each 4day expedition, Monday-Thursday, is \$180.00 per explorer. There is a total of six expeditions.
- All payments are due at the time of registration. All explorers must be registered and paid in advance. There are 40 spots, per expedition, available.
- Please bring ID when picking up and make sure your authorized pick-up persons are listed so we may release your explorer safely and appropriately.
- Explorers may be signed in as early as 8:00am and must be picked up by 5pm at the very latest. This is strictly enforced by SJCSD.
- Explorers must have a change of clothes, water bottle and full lunch in hand when checked in. A mid-morning and afternoon snack will be provided.
- We will be tasting snacks from each country we visit. Please list ALL known food allergies on your explorer's registration form

Julington Creek Elementary Summer Enrichment Camp Expectations Policy

Parent's Expectations of the Program:

Student Behavior Expectations:

- Be courteous when others are talking
- Use inside voices while inside
- Follow safety guidelines and rules while on school property
- Clean up after yourself and help your group leader and others clean up as well
- Respect others and their property
- No physical violence (hitting, punching, kicking, biting, tripping, spitting) toward another person
- No bullying
- Do not pick up rocks or sticks while on school property
- No chewing gum on school property
- Cell phones must remain in back packs at all times
- Electronic games that do not have internet access are allowed when teacher gives permission at appropriate times

Discipline and Consequences

A pattern of continuous behavior issues may lead to a temporary suspension or a removal from the Julington Creek Elementary Summer Camp.
