WELCOME!

The following are some very important procedures and requests that we would like to share with you:

- **Camp Extreme is open to all current K-5th graders (2024-2025 school year).**
- **Non-Refundable Registration fee is \$100 per week, per child.**
- **Each 4-day Extreme Camp week, Monday- Thursday, is \$175.00 per child.**
- **Please register, and pay registration fee, for each week you plan for your child to attend. Registration and fee will reserve their space for your chosen camp week. Each week has 40 extreme spaces available.**
- **Camp fees, \$175 per week, per child, must be paid one full week in advance before your chosen week of camp begins.**
- **Please bring ID when picking up and make sure your authorized pick-up persons are listed so we may release your child safely and appropriately.**
- **Kiddos may be signed in as early as 8:00am and must be picked up by 4:30pm at the very latest. This is strictly enforced by SJGSD.**
- **Please be sure your child has a change of clothes (if you feel it is needed), water bottle and a full lunch in hand when checked in. A mid-morning and afternoon snack will be provided.**
- **Sneakers Please. We will be running and playing ALL day!**
 - * **Please no sandal's, Crocs, or flip-flops**

Julington Creek Elementary Summer Enrichment Camp Expectations Policy

Parent's Expectations of the Program:

1. Their children are cared for in a safe supportive environment.
2. They may visit with the director regarding concerns related to their child or the program.
3. They will be informed of any misbehavior on the part of their child and may visit the director to bring about improvement in the situation.
4. Julington Creek Elementary Summer Camp will provide a caring staff, who shows genuine respect for the children and has confidence in each child's potential and promote each child's self-esteem.
5. Julington Creek Elementary Summer Camp will provide for the children a variety of developmentally appropriate activities, including crafts, active play, games, and social skills building.

Program Expectations of the Parent:

1. Keep your child's records complete and up to date.
2. Pick up your children on time.
3. Pay attention to any communication from the director regarding your child's behavior and cooperate in efforts to bring about improvement in the situation.
4. Provide communication between yourself and Julington Creek Elementary Summer Camp staff regarding a change in your child's home experience so we can work as partners in meeting the needs of your child.

Student Behavior Expectations:

Students will...

- Be kind to others
- Always stay within sight of the group leader
- Share equipment and take turns properly
- Use appropriate language- no cussing, no name calling, no racial slurs
- Be courteous when others are talking
- Use inside voices while inside
- Follow safety guidelines and rules while on school property
- Clean up after yourself and help your group leader and others clean up as well
- Respect others and their property
- No physical violence (hitting, punching, kicking, biting, tripping, spitting) toward another person
- No bullying
- Do not pick up rocks or sticks while on school property
- No chewing gum on school property
- Cell phones must always remain in back packs
- Electronic games that do not have internet access are allowed when teacher gives permission at appropriate times

Discipline and Consequences

Parents will be notified when their child is unable to meet our student behavior expectations. A pattern of continuous behavior issues may lead to a temporary suspension or a removal from the Julington Creek Elementary Summer Camp. An offense of physical nature, such as biting, punching, kicking, pulling hair or spitting will immediately lead to a temporary suspension and any further offenses thereafter will lead to permanent removal from the Julington Creek Elementary Summer Camp. Any student who uses physical force with a group leader will immediately and permanently be suspended from the program as well. ***Refunds Due to Suspension from Program-** All tuitions paid prior to your student's temporary or permanent suspension will be forfeited.

Medical Alert Disclosure

If your child has an allergy/medical condition, a detailed “medical alert” will be disclosed on the group leader’s attendance sheet. This is a continued effort to keep every group leader in every center aware of every child’s medical concerns.

We are aware of the sensitive nature of this information; therefore, one copy (the Group Leader’s copy) will have detailed information about your child’s allergy/medical condition, while the other copy (parent check-out copy) will not have any detailed information. While our staff recognizes that this information is a private matter, there is always a chance that the other students may observe the information on the attendance sheet due to the close interaction that the students and group leaders have.

Discipline Policy

We understand that summer camp is a financial investment, therefore, parents will be notified when their child is unable to meet our student behavior expectations. Continuous behavior issues, or a pattern of disruption to other students camp experience, may lead to a temporary suspension or a removal from the *JCE Summer Camp*. An offense of physical nature, such as biting, punching, kicking, pulling hair or spitting will immediately lead to a temporary suspension and any further offenses thereafter will lead to permanent removal from the *JCE Summer Camp*. Any student who uses physical force with a group leader will immediately and permanently be suspended from the program as well.

***Refunds Due to Suspension from Program-** All tuitions paid prior to your student’s temporary or permanent suspension will be forfeited.

If physician cannot be reached, *JCE Summer Camp* is authorized to make necessary arrangements to provide care and treatment for my child. In the event of an accident or illness that does not require immediate medical attention but does require immediate pick-up, *JCE Summer Camp* will contact me to make transportation arrangements for my child. If *JCE Summer Camp* is unable to reach me, I authorize them to contact one of the persons on my alternate pick-up list and request them to transport my child home.
