The following are some very important procedures and requests when joining us for summer camp:

- Camp Sigma is open to all current K-5th graders (2025-2026 school year).
- Each 4-day week, Monday- Thursday, 7:30am-4:30pm, is \$275.00 per child.
- A Non-refundable camp deposit of \$100 per week per child, is due with each registration week chosen.
- The final \$175.00 per week must be paid at least one week before the start of your selected camp week.
- Please register, and pay all deposits due, for each week you plan for your child to attend. Registration and deposit will reserve their space for your chosen camp week.
- Each week is limited to 40 spaces.
- When picking up your camper, please bring picture ID. When filling out registration, please add any authorized pick-up person so we may release your child safely and appropriately.
- Kiddos may be signed in as early as 7:30am and must be picked up by 4:30pm at the very latest. This is strictly enforced by SJCSO.
- Please be sure your child has a change of clothes (if you feel it is needed), water bottle and a full lunch in hand when checked in. A mid-morning and afternoon snack will be provided.
- Sneakers Please. We will be running and playing ALL day!

* Please no sandals, Crocs, or flip-flops

Julington Creek Elementary Summer Enrichment Camp Expectations Policy

Parent's Expectations of the Program:

1. Their children are cared for in a safe supportive environment.
2. They may visit with the director regarding concerns related to their child or the program.
3. They will be informed of any misbehavior on the part of their child and may visit the director to bring about improvement in the situation.
4. Julington Creek Elementary Summer Camp will provide a caring staff, who show genuine respect for the children and has confidence in each child's potential and promote each child's self-esteem.
5. Julington Creek Elementary Summer Camp will provide for the children a variety of developmentally appropriate activities, including crafts, active play, games, and social skills building.

Program Expectations of the Parent:

1. Keep your child's records complete and up to date.
2. Pick up your children on time.
3. Pay attention to any communication from the director regarding your child's behavior and cooperate in efforts to bring about improvement in the situation.
4. Provide communication between yourself and Julington Creek Elementary Summer Camp staff regarding a change in your child's home experience so we can work as partners in meeting the needs of your child.

Student Behavior Expectations:

Students will...

- Be kind to others
- Always stay within sight of the group leader
- Share equipment and take turns properly
- Use appropriate language- no cussing, no name calling, no racial slurs
- Be courteous when others are talking
- Use inside voices while inside
- Follow safety guidelines and rules while on school property
- Clean up after yourself and help your group leader and others clean up as well
- Respect others and their property
- No physical violence (hitting, punching, kicking, biting, tripping, spitting) toward another person
- No bullying
- Do not pick up rocks or sticks while on school property
- No chewing gum on school property
- Cell phones must always remain in backpacks
- Electronic games and iPad are not permitted

Discipline and Consequences

Parents will be notified when their child is unable to meet our student behavior expectations. A pattern of continuous behavior issues may lead to a temporary suspension or a removal from the Julington Creek Elementary Summer Camp. An offense of physical nature, such as biting, punching, kicking, pulling hair or spitting will immediately lead to a temporary suspension and any further offenses thereafter will lead to permanent removal from the Julington Creek Elementary Summer Camp. Any student who uses physical force with a group leader will immediately and permanently be suspended from the program as well.

***Refunds Due to Suspension from Program-** All tuition paid prior to your student's temporary or permanent suspension will be forfeited.
