Students must meet the eligibility requirements by Thurs., Feb. 28th to be invited to attend the BOB team tryouts, which will be held in the Media Center on Weds., March 6th at 8AM. Students who have already qualified will begin receiving invitations and parent permission forms the first week in February. Permission forms must be signed and returned to Mrs. Le or Mrs. Fuhr in the Media Center no later than Tues., March 5th. Students who are selected for the BOB team will be notified by Thurs., March 7th, and our first team meeting will take place at 8am on Weds., March 13th.


Annual Student Variety Show

SUMMER MARINE SCIENCE PROGRAM

Applications for the summer Marine Science Program will be passed out by 5th grade science teachers at all schools during the week of February 11th. Applications will be due back to science teachers by March 5th. Applications can also be downloaded at any time from the website prior to April 12th at http://www-grms.stjohns.k12.fl.us/ and click on the Marine Science link. The link also will have a complete day by day curriculum for each grade level, parent information, and a video from last year's program.

This summer program is available to all students currently in grades five through seven and has been sponsored by the school district since 1982. Three eight day sessions are held at Gamble Rogers Middle School with bus transportation provided. The dates for the three sessions this summer will be May 29th through June 7th, June 10th through June 20th, and June 24th through July 3rd. Small classes of 12-14 students are separated by grade level. All instructors in the program are St. Johns County School District teachers.

The Marine Science Program is a carefully designed experience for responsible students who are interested in learning about our local marine environments. Learning is "hands on" in the field with students kayaking, canoeing, boating, hiking, snorkeling, sailing, windsurfing, surfing, SUP, (stand up paddleboarding), etc. Specific grade level activities and curriculum are attached to the applications and are also available from the website.
