Representatives will be on hand to provide information about mentoring students in the SJCSD. Mentor training will also be provided to interested individuals and a continental breakfast will be available.

Mentors give approximately 45 minutes per week to meet with a student and support him/her in academic pursuits, and other goals. No prior experience is required and background screening and training are provided at no cost. SUMMER MARINE SCIENCE PROGRAM

Applications for the summer Marine Science Program will be passed out by science teachers during the week of February 10th. Applications will be due back to science teachers by February 28th. Applications can also be downloaded from the website prior to April 6th at <u>http://www-grms.stjohns.k12.fl.us/</u> and click on the Marine Science link. The link also will have a complete day by day curriculum for each grade level, parent information, and a video from last year's program.

This summer program is available to all students currently in grades five through seven. Three eight-day sessions are held at Gamble Rogers Middle School with bus transportation provided. The dates for the three sessions this summer will be June 1st through June 11th, June 15th through June 25th, and June 29th through July 9th (Monday-Thursday). Small classes of 12-14 students are separated by grade level. All instructors in the program are St. Johns County School District teachers.

Dear Parents,

The Variety Show tryouts are quickly approaching, and we know the children are working hard on their acts! ⁽²⁾ We have just a few reminders. There will be only one tryout date, **Thursday, February 20th**, from 6:30 P.M. - 8:30 P.M. on the stage in the cafeteria due to availability of judges and availability of the cafeteria. A **parent MUST be present for his/her child's tryout**. Videotaping instead of trying out is not permitted. Ex. My child will be out of town the evening of the tryouts.

The following criteria MUST be adhered to please:

- All printed words to songs must be attached to try-out sheet. Words/lyrics to songs must be elementary school appropriate as well as Cheer/Dance/Gymnastic moves.
- Students will not be allowed to sing along with the words/lyrics of prerecorded music. Music must be accompaniment only or Karaoke versions. These may be available on iTunes.
- ONLY CDs formatted for a CD player (CDR NOT CD-RW's), or flash drives with file formats of WAV, MP3, MP4, M4A, WMA will be accepted for the tryouts, dress rehearsal, and performances. NO cell phones, and You-Tube videos allowed.
- Lip-syncing will NOT be permitted.
- Acts should not be longer than approximately 3 minutes, and not shorter than 1 minute.
- 6) One act per child. You cannot perform an act from a previous Variety Show entry.
- 7) Costumes may be worn during the tryouts, but are not required.
- 8) Mandatory dress rehearsal <u>date</u>: Wed., March 11th 2:45 5:30 P.M. on the stage. Students will call home after their act is completed. Please pick up your child from the cafeteria. There is a place on the permission slip to write the phone number for your child to call.

We would also appreciate it if you would talk to your child before the tryouts about realizing he/she may not be selected to participate in the show. Many acts may be worthy enough for the show, but the judges will be deciding upon a maximum of 18 acts. The judges' decisions are final, and no re-evaluations will be accepted. We would like to wish everyone "Good Luck!" ©

The show will be performed 3 times on Thursday, March 12 at 9:00 A.M., 1:30 P.M., and 6:30 P.M. in JCE's cafeteria. Please note that there will be a monetary donation of \$3.00 for adults, \$2.00 for students, and \$6.00 for families at the door that you may give at the evening performance to help cover the expenses of the shows. We would like to wish everyone "Good Luck!"

Please return the attached form and permission slip to Mrs. Isabelle by Wednesday, February 19th. NO forms will be accepted the day of the tryouts – Thurs., Feb. 20th; NO EXCEPTIONS! <u>Turn in only one form and one permission slip per act</u>.
