



We are seeking parents or guardians to visit JCE and speak to our 4th and 5th graders about their careers. The event will take place on Thursday, April 17th, from 8:30 AM to 10:30 AM. (8:15 arrival)

Participants will be stationed in the cafeteria, where students will rotate through in small groups. You will provide a brief 30-45 second overview of your job, covering topics such as:

- Post-high school education (if any)
- Tools you use in your profession
- A typical day in your career
- Your favorite aspect of your job
- The average salary for your profession

Please be prepared to answer questions from the students. Each class will have a 25-minute block to visit multiple careers, so interactions will be brief and frequent.

We ask that you wear your work attire and bring items that might interest the students, such as tools, products you help create, brochures, business cards, or company swag. These items should be small enough to hold (you won't have to hold them), as space is limited, and are for display only, not to be taken home by the students.

We hope this will be a rewarding experience for both you and our students as they look to you for inspiration and begin to consider their own futures.


