

#### **Information for Upcoming Kindergarteners**

No kindergarteners will be able to start school without submitting all of the required documentation. Please see the school website for more information.

Kindergarteners "Stagger Start" from Monday, August 12—Thursday, August 15. Each student is assigned ONE day that they attend during those first four days. ALL kindergarteners will then attend school on Friday, August 16. Please contact the front office if there is a specific day you would like to request for your student's stagger start.

On **Wednesday, May 1** you can stop in to take care of any of the following: Kindergarten tours, verification of registration documents, and Extended Day Q&A and application/fee drop off for fully registered kindergarteners. Representatives will be here from 3:30 pm until 6:00 pm. The last tour will begin at 5:30. Students are welcome to attend.

A "Meet the Teacher" Kindergarten Night will be scheduled close to the beginning of the school year. Check the school website throughout the summer for more information.

#### **CLINIC NEWS**

Letters will be going out to any parent who has a student with medications kept in the clinic. This includes daily medications, any over the counter as needed medications or emergency meds (inhalers, epi pens, etc). ALL Medications must be picked up from the clinic! No medications will be kept over the summer. It will be important for you to make arrangements to pick up your child's medications. Any medication left in the clinic after Tuesday, May 28<sup>th</sup> @ 11 a.m. will be discarded according to Saint Johns County School District policy. Medication forms will be sent in your letter and are available over the summer online or at the front desk. Medication orders must be completed every year whether your child remains in the same school or goes to another Saint Johns County school.

The clinic will reopen Thursday, August 8<sup>th</sup> to accept your child's medication and completed forms. **Medications will not be accepted without a completed form.** 

Snack-size ziplock bags and latex-free band aids are always welcome donations for the clinic.
