

Safer, Smarter Kids

Dear Parent or Caregiver,

Your child will be participating in the Safer, Smarter Kids safety curriculum that is mandated by the state. It is developed by Lauren Book, M.S.Ed., along with a developmental psychologist and career educators. This developmentally-appropriate curriculum will arm your child with protective principles and the knowledge needed to identify and avoid unsafe situations, people and behaviors – and how to access help. The curriculum will be taught in your student's class in the month of November by the school counselors.

Some of the topics the children will study are body boundaries, respecting themselves and others, and using their voice to tell a trusted adult in their Safety NETwork when a situation makes them feel confused or uncomfortable.




