Principal's Report:

Mrs. Murphy welcomed everyone to the September SAC meeting. Mrs. Murphy shared that JCE is one of the largest elementary schools in the county with 958 students. Mrs. Murphy presented the 2018-19 JCE School Improvement Plan with the group. First, she opened with celebrations. Congratulations to our fifth grade Odyssey of the Mind team for their success in their inaugural year. Our second celebration is that our fifth grade science scores continued to rise. Celebration three highlighted the growth of the bottom 25 % that made learning gains. Mrs. Murphy shared the disparities as a school. The three disparities were ELA learning gains, phonics skills, and STEM. Our school is addressing these disparities through PLC, Essential Standards Training, and Win-Win groups. We will use the SIPPS (phonics based intervention) program as well as formative assessments to address phonics. To enhance disparity number three, students will receive STEM as part of their resource rotation and be given an opportunity to experience Career Readiness Field Studies. Mrs. Murphy continued the presentation by sharing the STEM coding lab and our Super Jag Extreme Program.
